25 MARCEL: Where?

27 DISPATCH: Hello?

29 MARCEL: Where his bag at, (AJ)?

31 DISPATCH: Hello?

33 MARCEL: 1734 7th Street East.

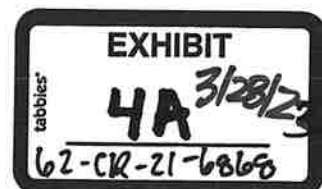

35 DISPATCH: Are you at the Speedway?

37 MARCEL: No, I'm on 7th and Flandrau.

39 DISPATCH: Okay. Well you gave me an address for Speedway. Where are you?

43 Woman: (Unintelligible).

45 MARCEL: ...1734 7th Street East.  
46  
47 Woman: I'm on the phone.  
48  
49 DISPATCH: What city are you in?  
50  
51 Man: I don't know where I'm (unintelligible).  
52  
53 Woman: Where are you stabbed? Are (unintelligible)?  
54  
55 DISPATCH: Hello?  
56  
57 MARCEL: Hello?  
58  
59 MARCEL: Yes. 1734 7th Street East.  
60  
61 DISPATCH: What's going on there?  
62  
63 MARCEL: Somebody stabbed him in the alley. I don't know.  
64  
65 DISPATCH: Somebody what?  
66  
67 MARCEL: Somebody got - somebody stabbed him in the alley.  
68  
69 DISPATCH: Okay. And you're at 7th and Flandrau?  
70  
71 MARCELL: 7th and Flandrau.  
72  
73 DISPATCH: What's your name, please? What is your name, please?  
74  
75 MARCEL: My name is Mar...  
76  
77 MARCEL: ...my name is Marcel.  
78  
79 DISPATCH: What's your phone number, Marcel?  
80  
81 Woman: Hurry. (Unintelligible).  
82  
83 MARCEL: 952-228-3600.  
84  
85 Woman: I need help.  
86  
87 DISPATCH: Is the person that stabbed him still there? Hold on one second  
88  
89 MARCEL: I don't know. No... yes, he's still here!  
90

91 DISPATCH: Okay. You need to stop shouting and take a breath so I can get a medical  
92 dispatcher on with us. Hold on one second.  
93  
94 MARCEL: I don't know what the fuck to do, bro.  
95  
96 MEDICS: Fire and medical emergency.  
97  
98 DISPATCH: Someone was stabbed in the alley behind 7th Street and Flandrau.  
99  
100 MEDICS: Okay. Thank you.  
101  
102 MEDICS: Hello, caller?  
103  
104 MARCEL: Yes.  
105  
106 MEDICS: Are you at 7th and Flandrau?  
107  
108 MARCEL: Yes.  
109  
110 MEDICS: What's the phone number?  
111  
112 MARCEL: 952-228-3600.  
113  
114 MEDICS: Okay. And who was stabbed, a male or female?  
115  
116 MARCEL: A male.  
117  
118 MEDICS: Okay. Are you with him right now?  
119  
120 MARCEL: Yes, my mom's in the house. He's dying.  
121  
122 MEDICS: How old is he? How old is he?  
123  
124 MARCEL: He's not breathing.  
125  
126 MEDICS: How old is he?  
127  
128 MARCEL: I don't know. You need to get here!  
129  
130 MEDICS: Take a guess, 20, 50, 80?  
131  
132 MARCEL: I don't know!  
133  
134 MEDICS: Okay. Is he awake?  
135  
136 MARCEL: Bro, somebody just stabbed AJ!

137  
138 DISPATCH: Is he awake?  
139  
140 MARCEL: Hey get up!! AJ! AJ! Bro, police are on their way. Come on, let's bring him to  
141 the hospital.  
142  
143 MEDICS: Ma'am, the pa- sir...the paramedics are already on the way. Is he breathing?  
144  
145 MARCEL: The white man...the older dude right there stabbed him he said.  
146  
147 MEDICS: Sir, is he breathing?  
148  
149 MARCEL: right there at the end of the alley.  
150  
151 MEDICS: Hello?  
152  
153 MARCEL: You said what?  
154  
155 MEDICS: Is he breathing? Okay. What address are you at?  
156  
157 MARCEL: 1734 7th Street East!  
158  
159 MEDICS: Okay. Is someone else there on the phone with 911?  
160  
161 MARCEL: Yes. Hey.  
162  
163 MEDICS: Okay.  
164  
165 MARCEL: Please. He got - hurry up, please!  
166  
167 MEDICS: Okay. We already have a paramedic on the way. 1734 7th Street East?  
168  
169 MARCEL: Yes, ma'am, please.  
170  
171 MEDICS: Okay.  
172  
173 MEDICS: Are you at a house?  
174  
175 MARCEL: Yes, ma'am.  
176  
177 MEDICS: Okay. Where on his body was he stabbed?  
178  
179 MARCEL: 17 - huh?  
180  
181 MEDICS: Where...  
182

183 MARCEL: It happened in the alley, ma'am.

185 MEDICS: No...  
186  
187 MARCEL: We don't know. It was in the alley.  
188  
189 MEDICS: ...where on his body....Sir, where on his body was he stabbed?  
190  
191 MARCEL: Yes, he was stabbed.  
192  
193 MEDICS: Okay. You keep saying yes. Listen to what I'm asking you. Where on his body  
194 was he stabbed?  
195  
196 MARCEL: It looks like his chest, his chest.  
197  
198 MEDICS: Chest. Is he breathing?  
199  
200 MARCEL: No, he's not breathing. Ma'am, he's not.  
201  
202 MEDICS: Okay. Can we get him down on the ground, flat on his back?  
203  
204 MARCEL: Actually, yes, ma'am, he is breathing. Please. Yes...  
205  
206 MEDICS: Okay.  
207  
208 MARCEL: ...he is breathing.  
209  
210 MEDICS: He's breathing. All right. Okay. We already have a paramedic in route. Can  
211 you put a – anything clean, dry cloth over the wound and apply pressure?  
212  
213 MARCEL: I am applying pressure. (AJ), stay with...  
214  
215 MEDICS: Okay.  
216  
217 MARCEL: ...me, brother.  
218  
219 MEDICS: Hold - hold the...  
220  
221 MARCEL: Stay - get up - (AJ), stay with me, brother.  
222  
223 MEDICS: Okay. Listen to my...

225 MEDICS: ...instruction.

227 MARCEL: (Unintelligible).

229 Woman: (Unintelligible).

231 MEDICS: Hold the...

233 MARCEL: (Unintelligible).

235 Woman: (Unintelligible) still breathing.

237 Man: (Unintelligible).

239 MARCEL: He's talking.

241 Woman: (AJ).

243 Man: (Unintelligible).

245 Woman: (AJ). (AJ).

247 Man 1: (Unintelligible).

249 Woman: Motherfucking God...

251 MEDICS: Sir?

253 Woman: ...where's the fucking ambulance?

255 MEDICS: Okay.

257 MARCEL: (Unintelligible).

259 MEDICS: The ambulance is...

261 MARCEL: (Unintelligible) breathe.

263 MEDICS: ...on the way.

265 MARCEL: (Unintelligible).

267 MEDICS: Sir, I'm trying to help you and you're not listening. Please listen to me. Hold  
268 the...

270 MARCEL: Yeah.  
271  
272 MEDICS: Hold the clean, dry cloth over the wound on his chest. Okay? And...

274 MARCEL: I'm holding (unintelligible).

276 MEDICS: ...apply pressure. Don't lift up.  
277  
278 MARCEL: Yes, I am applying pressure.  
279  
280 MEDICS: Okay. Good. All right.  
281  
282 Man 2: Hey - hey, can we take him to the hospital, brother?  
283  
284 DISPATCH: Marcel?  
285  
286 MEDICS: Okay.  
287  
288 DISPATCH: Sorry.  
289  
290 MEDICS: Go ahead. Do you have further questions?  
291  
292 DISPATCH: Yeah.  
293  
294 MEDICS: We're gonna stand by. Thank you.  
295  
296 DISPATCH: Thank you. Marcel? Hello? Do you know who did this?  
297  
298 MARCEL: No, ma'am, it was a white guy.

300 DISPATCH: Okay. Did you get a clothing description of him at all?

302 MARCEL: No.

304 DISPATCH: Okay- tell her the police and the medics are already on the way and tell her -  
305 she needs to stop screaming.
