These recordings were taken by an anonymous source inside of Patriot Front during August to December 2021. Unicorn Riot has produced transcript PDFs, MP3s and videos from this set of recordings. The transcripts and the Mp3s use the same set of timecodes. The main report on our website uses separate timecodes that match our videos, which are lightly edited to remove silence, with an additional introduction and credits.

The .mp3 files (as opposed to slightly shortened videos) represent the uncut documentation of these Patriot Front voice meetings. These uncut audio files have been altered as little as possible in the interests of source protection.

Accuracy of transcripts and speaker identities

Unicorn Riot has done our best to compile transcripts with the most accurate time stamps and speaker identifications possible. Due to the combination of machine transcription and extensive human labor, there may be occasional errors in speaker IDs indicated in transcripts. but we are confident that the vast majority of the speaker IDs and content are correct. Some transcript timestamps are incorrect due to unavoidable issues with using machine transcription at scale, however, the majority are accurate.

Please note that these recordings may include Patriot Front members whose voices were not identified by us. When we were unsure about a speaker's identity we have left that line in the transcript without an assigned name, which machine transcription services usually tag as 'Unknown'. Many Patriot Front members have been identified by researchers, activists and journalists by linking multiple pieces of evidence to online personas.

If we do it Saturday night instead we'll have more sleep, but guys that are having to drive home will spend their Sunday, part of their Sunday driving home. So I'm going to give a few minutes and wait for Frederick to pop in here and, you know, because he's driving quite a ways too and I want to hear from him his take, but you'll have Johnny Idaho, Frederick Oregon, Leo Oregon and Alexander Oregon. So that's four guys. I'm sure they can all lay down on sleeping roll or some foam or something and crash like in your living room or something. If this is okay with you.

Okay, I'm planning a really big action for us. And we're gonna want to do it like at 2 a.m. on either Friday night or Saturday night, um, what would you prefer?

Uh, doesn't matter to me.

Okay. If it's Friday night, I mean, I'm gonna be, you know, getting off work, I'm gonna be tired, we're gonna have to stay up and pull an action. I'll start drinking Bang a little later in the day.

I spent about two hours with Clarke scouting this location. And we are definitely going to need all hands on deck and I'll brief you guys all before the action and tell you what I need you to do. I'm going to assign roles to everyone for this action to ensure the safety and completion of said action, there is a small chance that you know, all of us could end up going to jail. But I want to say about a two percent chance. So a lot lower, a lot lower than the mural that we did in Portland, you know, with more guys means there's more lookout and we'll be able to be a lot safer. The environment, there is little to no vehicles that will be passing by, my only, my only issue is like maybe a pedestrian sees us doing it, calls the cops and the cops get the description of my vehicle and we get stopped. But I find that to be extremely low, especially considering our opposition does not believe in calling the police. But that doesn't mean that they haven't done that in the past before, right? So as long as we're speedy in and out, I think we can complete it in less than five minutes. And police's response time is usually longer than that. You know.

And I think, I think it'll be rather quick. It'll be rather smooth. Um. And I was debating how comfortable, you guys with the big banner stencils, do you think with all of us and the help of Oregon, we could pull those off, putting those on a wall, um, in under five minutes? Or do you think we should play it safe and we should like, use the 'United We Stand', uh, mini-banner stencil?

I think we got to go big or go home, man. That's where I stand on this.

Yeah.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 24:20

I think with the Oregon guys, I mean, I think five minutes is well, I think we could do it in less than that.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 24:26

Because I was, I was thinking with the banner size stencils and the URL we could, um, and this is really flat. It's not, there's not a bunch of rocks, like it's not going to be super dark, it's gonna be lit up. So you know, we'd be able to be pretty organized about workspace. We'll have two guys that fold the stencils up and then three guys fill in with a can of Montana paint and then, um, drop the stencil, fold it up, set it down nicely, pick up the next one and do it again. So, um, everyone's gonna have a 4X turbo can, white out the whole motherfucker, and then, um, just wait a couple seconds to let it dry and then slap our stencils up. It is important that we do let it dry, um. So you're gonna want to not do too heavy of a coat. Um. The one we did in Portland, we whited it out, then we took off and then we came back and then we stenciled it some more. So we let it dry for a minute. I think at 2 a.m. it's going to be super dead. There's going to be no one around. And I think our lookouts, they scare people off from even like, bothering us. There's an idea. So what if someone's approaching, you know, they're kind of interested. And then, you know, Frederick or Tyler literally like, runs them off. But that poses, you know what if they try to fight you or something.

Frederick OR (Lawrence Norman) 25:53

I can just look like a straight up hood.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 25:55

[Laughs]

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 25:58

Yeah.

Frederick OR (Lawrence Norman) 25:59

People will cross the road to avoid me.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 26:02

Yeah, I think you just simply like, be guarding any onlooker that comes up, you know, and just being really close to them. They're going to be really uneased and they're going to, like not want to, not want to fuck with us. I mean, there's gonna be like ten of us total, so no one's gonna want to really try anything. My concern is them filming me getting into the truck. Um, Clarke, I want you to double check the area and where I said that I wanted to park the vehicle. Um. Make sure that there's absolutely no cameras, we're gonna tape the [inaudible] but you know, if my vehicle go on the news. Let's say my parents see it. They're like, hey, isn't that your truck. I'll be like, uh, I dunno, I plead the fifth.

I'll go, I'll go out there like during daylight hours so we can see better and just double check that, I'm pretty confident that there isn't anything aside from [inaudible].

Yeah, which we'll avoid completely on our, um, exit.

Also, I have some nitrile gloves that I can supply guys with. They are, uh, extra large, so I hope they, uh, they fit your hands.

Yeah you can bring those, I mean, I have, I have stuff too. So, um, I think I'm the guy with all the Montana paint. So I'm gonna have to share all that. Um. As for the banner stencils, who has, who has all the stencils right now? Is that Ethan or Vincent?

I was thinking, what if we did individual letters of that, cut the Coroplast, and then we did the, uh, accordion style fold with those, that way you don't have a blundering gigantic stencil but it's portable enough to like, put in your coat or your backpack and it's still big. We got the letters, they're in, they're in the roll of stencils we need to cut out. I either have those or those are at Tyler's house and I know Tyler won't get them done so someone's gonna have to retrieve them from him and cut them on some Coroplast. But that's an option too. And I was thinking like a "Not Stolen, Conquered" [inaudible]. "One Nation Against Invasion", we need anti...oh, "Strong Family Strong Nations". I think that's a good rebuttal to any homosexual propaganda, what do you think?

Hey boss, uh, two things, one, it might be advisable that we get a tarp for the back of your truck in case, one...
