

2021-11-28 Last Mumble Before Dec Event

These recordings were taken by an anonymous source inside of Patriot Front during August to December 2021. Unicorn Riot has produced transcript PDFs, MP3s and videos from this set of recordings. The transcripts and the Mp3s use the same set of timecodes. The main report on our website uses separate timecodes that match our videos, which are lightly edited to remove silence, with an additional introduction and credits.

The .mp3 files (as opposed to slightly shortened videos) represent the uncut documentation of these Patriot Front voice meetings. These uncut audio files have been altered as little as possible in the interests of source protection.

Accuracy of transcripts and speaker identities

Unicorn Riot has done our best to compile transcripts with the most accurate time stamps and speaker identifications possible. Due to the combination of machine transcription and extensive human labor, there may be occasional errors in speaker IDs indicated in transcripts. but we are confident that the vast majority of the speaker IDs and content are correct. Some transcript timestamps are incorrect due to unavoidable issues with using machine transcription at scale, however, the majority are accurate.

Please note that these recordings may include Patriot Front members whose voices were not identified by us. When we were unsure about a speaker's identity we have left that line in the transcript without an assigned name, which machine transcription services usually tag as 'Unknown'. Many Patriot Front members have been identified by researchers, activists and journalists by linking multiple pieces of evidence to online personas.

David said he'll be late, Clarke should be, should be eight minutes late. I don't know if we'll wait that long though.

Hey, hey Jack, do you mind if Frederick and I and Leo like, sleep on your floor on Thursday night?

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 01:12

Thursday night? Is that the night before we leave?

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 01:15

Yes, that's the night before we leave.

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 01:18

That's fine by me. I've got a couple of cots, although one of them broke already so I've got two cots.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 01:24

You know my beliefs towards sleeping on the floor. I love the floor. So anybody else can always have the cots.

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 01:32

Well, the floor loves you.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 01:34

Yes, it does!

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 01:35

Yeah, you're definitely welcome to come by.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 01:39

Thank you.

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 01:40

You're probably going to meet an ex-member, he's going to be staying with, he's going to be watching my house for a little while. The former Aaron Washington.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 01:50

Ooh.

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 01:50

He's a good dude. He'll be watching my house while we're at the demo. Because I, did I, did John tell you? I got broken into twice in one week.

Holy shit!

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 02:00

Last week. Oh, yeah.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 02:01

I thought your area was pretty good. Damn.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 02:04

It was twice? I heard it was once.

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 02:06

It was twice. First I found this homeless guy in my laundry room. I, he was down on his luck, like 25, on drugs. Had like a, my laundry basket full of my shit when I caught him and I was like, "Dude, not cool!" You know, "I'm sorry." The whole thing. I showed him where the Salvation Army was. He told me he left his phone in my laundry room and I was like, "Listen, man, if I find your phone, I'll leave it at the Salvation Army." I did find his phone, dropped it off there like two nights go by, I get a knock on my door in the middle of the night. It's him again apologizing for breaking and entering but also wanted to know if I had his phone. I told him I dropped it off at Salvation Army. The next night, I'm out of town. I'm at a friend's wedding and my tenant calls me, sure enough, somebody was trying to break in that night too. This time though they had tools. They tried to bust the lock and doorknob off my back door.

So, I had to get a new door, get new get new locks. Yep, she caught him running away with a flashlight, ski mask and all black clothing. So they were trying to bust in here. So I had to take the last couple days to up my security a little bit. I got more stuff in the works. But yeah...

You got to go full Home Alone style now man.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 03:22

I just watched that movie and I was like, I should be taking notes.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 03:25

Did you watch the remake or, or the original?

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 03:30

No, the old one.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 03:30

Oh okay, good. Yeah.

03:36

There's a remake?

Apparently, my boss was telling me about it today.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 03:48

No, I have not seen it.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 04:09

Are you guys ready to get rolling?

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 04:15

I'm going to call Leo Oregon on Telegram. Be right back.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 04:19

Okay. Who are we missing out of Network 8? Paul, we're missing Paul Washington.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 04:51

Is that someone new? I've never heard of Paul.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 04:56

Yeah, he just joined. But I don't know, probably better because of the "need to know principle" since he's obviously not going to the event that he's not here. There we go.

Clarke's rolling into the meeting on some heavy machinery it sounds like.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 05:39

Yeah, I was just walking past my coworker and I still had on the continuous transmission from yesterday. That's just the noise you make when you move around, Clarke, we all know it. Yeah, I'm just cleaning up right now.

Jack WA (Matthew Clement) 06:11

Who are we still waiting for?

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 06:14

Alexander's calling Leo. I guess we could just get started with like, the debrief, even if they're not here. What, Vincent? You went down to Oregon right?

06:28

Indeed, yep. I went down with with Clarke. We went down to help Leo interview someone who ended up no-showing.

06:38

And I don't know if we've heard back from them, from that guy since.

06:43

Went down there to interview, didn't end up having that happen. So we went and stickered and dropped the banner.

No posters?

06:58

No, no posters. We had up, we had to head out because it was getting pretty late.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 07:08

Where did you guys drop the banner?

07:16

I don't know the, I don't know the address.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 07:18

It was, it was Highway 26. Eastbound, or, westbound, rather.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 07:27

Is that that little tunnel spot or something? I guess it doesn't really matter.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 07:30

Yeah, that was, that was the tunnel spot, it was eastbound into, into Portland.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 07:35

Okay, cool. Went well, nothing could have went better on it?

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 07:47

The zips are crap, that could have gone better, but...

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 07:56

Cool. Cool. I don't know. Vincent, you want to talk about postering? Or I could, it's up to you.

08:06

Yeah, sure. Postering, I thought, went pretty well.

08:09

Or it went well, for, for, for half of it.

08:12

We decided to go postering, I think on Friday night, was it, was it only Friday?

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 08:18

Yeah.

08:19

We had eight utility boxes that we were targeting in two locations.

08:25

Because, if you didn't know, a post for any large event like this, if it's stencils, or whatever, you need to do four for, you know, for pictures, or in this case for utility, for, for posting, you want to get four posters up, and that is a post.

08:46

So we had four boxes picked out in west Seattle and four picked out in White Center.

08:52

The west Seattle ones went through pretty easily. I've done postering before.

08:57

So my goal is to, I guess, teach other people who are coming along with me, and Ethan came along.

09:03

It went smoothly. Got posters up in four locations.

09:07

And then we moved on to White Center where things weren't as, weren't as smooth.

09:14

We went to our first box, sprayed some wheatpaste on it, and immediately the King County Sheriffs rolled in on us. I saw them at the intersection, called, called us off, we started walking down the street.

09:27

By that point, the Sheriff had already seen us and whoever they were, they came down and tried to cut us off at the alley.

09:33

But we ended up feinting them out pretty easily and got away, made it back to the vehicle, made it out safe and decided not to stick around there, because the number one rule of not being caught, and we made it out.

But for the west Seattle posters we managed to cover up a, some artwork of Angela Davis, who is a noted black Marxist, and we covered that one up with a "Better Dead than Red" poster.

10:05

So that was our victory of the night. I think that'll be a pretty good post.

10:09

In White Center, we were aiming to cover up a George Floyd utility box.

10:14

Didn't end up getting there, since the cops rolled in on us.

10:19

But I will say that it's already been covered up a couple of times, people have been spray painting over it, but hopefully we'll get that in the future.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 10:30

Right on, what do you think could have gone better? How could we have avoided what happened with the Sheriff's deputy?

10:43

Yeah, I think um, I was talking to John a little bit about this.

10:49

We have to be careful because anywhere where we're in Seattle, if we look too much like antifa, the cops will pay attention to that.

10:58

Situational awareness will always help.

11:00

And I think if we had more people, three is kind of the perfect number for that. You have two people who can do the postering and one person documenting.

11:08

It's kind of hard to watch if you don't have as many people doing the postering.

11:13

That said, you might bring more attention. I think over time we'll get better at doing this with speed.

11:21

And that'll help, although in this case, they rolled up on us like right at the beginning, right as, right as we were putting on the first layer of, of paste.

11:31

So yeah, that's, that's, that's about it.

11:35

As much as I can think of, like, just keeping our eyes open, recognizing police cars a little bit earlier and maybe having a third person so that we, we share the effort of postering a little bit more and then we, we can also have the extra person watching out.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 11:53

Maybe almost, sorry, was someone saying something? I thought I heard something. Yeah, maybe almost a fourth person. I don't know. Like you said, maybe that'll draw too much attention but, cause I

mean, yeah, ideally, I guess, two doing it, one documenting then maybe kind of a look out but, I don't know, what do you think?

Yeah, it's hard to say, I don't know. I've, I've only ever done it with two people.

12:25

I think last time I did was me and John. So I don't know like, I feel like three is the perfect number four might be, four might be good. It depends.

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 12:38

Three is like the most you ever really want to do in my experience with a poster, just because you can have one dedicated camera guy getting the whole like, you know, you, putting up the, up the adhesive and then putting up the poster and then that adhering the poster. But you, two is also extremely doable. It's just like, everything's contextual. Like it's all about, like where you're at what kind of like, what what the entire operation is going to look like. Like, if you're covering something up, that extra guy who's doing the camera work can always double out as a look out, like, "Oh hey, hey Vincent, there's a cop car down that street, just so you know," or whatever. So it's never bad to bring a third guy, but four is a bit too, a bit too much. Because four will always attract attention. You know, bigger fit looking-white guys is always going to, people always look at that because they're not used to seeing large groups of white men.

I also can personally feel that if we have like four or five guys we might as well just like do banner drops or something other than...

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 13:48

Yeah if you're gonna do four or five guys you guys should be covering up like a mural or something. Posters were kind of like yeah, that's that's like a two to three person activity.

We might have been doing it a little early for for the area as well, just because it's pretty close to Seattle and we were doing these between 10 and midnight.

14:11

So I think maybe doing them a little little later into the morning might help but that's not always...

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 14:17

Yeah. Bigger cities you kind of want to do them like you were covering up some, some fun stuff so so you want to do those a little later in the night. Again, like yeah, it all just depends on like what the area looks like and when you're covering something up, always, always scout it out before and then right before.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 14:43

Yeah, and I think it basically just came down to bad timing because, it was, what, a couple of seconds into it? Like I literally just started spraying the bottle and then you're like "cop, cop."

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 14:54

Yeah.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 14:59

Right on. Is that all the, the big actions that went on? The banner drop in Portland and poster? Anything else?

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 15:13

In regards to that banner drop, that put us, I believe that should put us at the 10 that John wants us to get per month. So I believe we did hit ten this month, at least.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 15:25

Right on. I guess we'll move on to fitness. Is everyone in the green on everything? Or is anybody not in the green on everything?

Alexander OR (Richard Flannery) 15:37

Um, I'm not in the green in pull-ups. But Brandon California and I were talking about that, and he gave me some good suggestions. So I'll be trying those out.

15:48

I do pull ups every day.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 15:57

I'm not, I'm not in the green on planking or pull-ups, but I'm working on it. Right on, yeah. The notes John wrote, he said "Everyone needs to be in the green by December 4th." I mean, obviously, we're not gonna get twice as strong overnight, so. Yeah, I guess just keep working on it, whatever. It is what it is, but maybe by the next event, that could be a good goal for us to all be in the green. Because I'm short, I'm short on pushups, too. So you guys aren't the only ones.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 16:37

Yeah, I'm like, right there on the, what do you call it. Like the edge of the push-ups and the plank. I'm like, almost in the green. And pull ups, I'm in the green but hesitantly like, three is really difficult, but I can do it.

If you guys want to get better at pull ups or push ups, you should be doing them every day. Just like do 100 push ups a day. But don't wear yourself out, just drop and do 10.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 17:04

And the goal should be to do 100 every single day. Never wear yourself out, and then you'll get better at it. Same with pull ups. If you can only do three, just put a bar up somewhere. And every time you

walk under it, just do one perfect pull up. Try to do like 15 every single day and it adds up over the week. And that really is how you get better at those exercises in a short amount of time.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 17:25

That's, that's a really good idea. I think I'll definitely take your advice on that one.

17:30

It's easy, man. Just if you, if you're struggling with push ups, just bang out 5 or 10 at a time, work up to 100 a day. I mean, that's 700 push ups in one week you will get better very quickly.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 17:41

Same with pull ups, if all you can do is three, just do one, and walk away and then come back an hour later and do one end up doing 10 a day, I mean, that's seventy a week. It really adds up, your nervous system gets really efficient.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 17:58

I'll start them tonight, thank you.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 18:05

Right on, and then, does anybody want to do anything? It says activity for next week? I don't know.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 18:14

I'm gonna be working right up until the demo or like, we have to catch our flight. So unless someone wants to do something down kind of where I'm at, real late at night, early in the morning, I'm kind of booked.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 18:34

Yeah, I don't know. I took Thursday off as well. So I'm off Thursday-Friday so I don't know, maybe if someone else is not busy we could just throw up a quick banner or something but if not, I don't think it's a big deal. Obviously the demo's more important. And then moving on down the list, does everyone have their uniform put together, does anybody not have their uniform put together that's going? Alright, so everyone's got it and I, have you guys all looked at the the packing list?

Yeah, I should have everything all packed up and ready to go by Thursday.

Okay, right on. Yeah, I'm sure everyone's seen all that, a couple times, so. And then, Christmas dinner. Yeah, I know we were talking about an Airbnb. Do you guys still want to do that? Like, do you guys actually want to put up money on that? Because, Tyler, you could chime in here, as far as I understand

it, what, basically John gave you some money and otherwise you paid for it yourself out of pocket? I don't know if you're planning on doing that?

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 20:09

Well, I did the last one, John said he was doing this one. So I gave him suggestions for Airbnb and, I don't know. He hasn't talked to me about if he's booked anything or not. Problem is, I mean, like I said, he said he was taking lead on it. We might not be able to get an Airbnb that we want this late. I mean, everything gets booked up this time.

Yeah, I was looking at them because I guess he was telling me about getting them, but I was looking, and after like, tax and all the fees and everything for like two nights, we were basically looking at like 700 bucks. Yeah, no, yeah, we don't expect you to get the next one too. I was just, yeah, I don't know. I guess I was just looking at them and he was wanting me to book it, but I was just thinking, like, if, you know, people don't want to put up like 60 bucks or whatever, then I don't really want to pay for it all myself. So I guess we'll just talk about that or something or we'll figure it out. I mean, me and John, maybe he wants to put up a little bigger, maybe if we split it or something, or somebody else wants to message me or John.

I mean, I could definitely put down a few hundred bucks, that's not an issue. Just got to figure out where it is because, I guess it's between your wife and my girlfriend to, to figure out a grocery list and do all the cooking as well, and that adds up.

Right, yeah, I was looking at like Puyallup was like \$700 for, accommodates eight. I don't know if it's still available. I'm sure it is, there was a couple good ones like that kind of in that area. But I don't know. I don't think you should really put up, I mean if you really want to, maybe, but yeah, we'll just talk about that later. We'll figure that out. So, I don't know. We're still looking at probably doing something on December 18. Maybe we could just get a reservation at like, a restaurant, like, my wife was talking like, Anthony's out there in Gig Harbor, like, that'd probably be cheaper for everyone just eat a meal

like, cooked for us than to like, rent an Airbnb. I know it's nice to kind of have our own spot and do the whole holiday event but I don't know, just an idea.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 23:17

I don't know about, is that in Kitsap County? Because they might require vaccination.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 23:25

I believe it's still Pierce County in Gig Harbor. But yeah, obviously, we got to avoid King County and what, Kitsap you can't eat indoors anymore?

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 23:41

I'm not sure if it's Kitsap as well. I just know that's a really liberal county so it wouldn't really surprise me if they follow the same as King County.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 23:57

Yeah, I guess that would just figure that deal out. Um, the main concern is this next weekend so, what does this say, does everyone know like, where they're parking or who they're meeting up with carpooling or should we start discussing that?

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 24:23

I am not sure. I know what I have going on.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 24:31

You know, you know what you got going on? What are you doing exactly, Clarke?

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 24:36

Because I get off work at about midnight on Thursday, I was just gonna head up and meet up with John, like, early in the morning I suppose. Or I was just gonna head the [inaudible] meetup point just kind of take a nap.

Ha! I'll take it. So yeah, that's, that's four of us. So and if all of us are going two vehicles, is that what you were saying, Vincent?

Where exactly are you parking? Do you know, are you parking like, on International Boulevard or one of those other lots, or what?

The place is called SeaTac Park. I'm not really sure where it's at. It is just, it is just really close right by the ramp to get on the airport. You could Google it. I'm not...I don't really know where it's at.

Ethan WA (Justin O'Leary) 29:21

Tou said it's called SeaTac Park?

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 29:23

Yeah. SeaTac Park. That's the business name. Yeah, it's on 200 street.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 29:43

That's where we're gonna be leaving the rest of the vehicles or is that where we're getting out?

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 29:52

That's where I'm parking my truck. And then we take a little bus that takes us to the airport.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 30:00

Got it.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 30:03

Once I get home here in like a half hour, I will send everyone the action plan. But long story short, it's going to be Maple Valley at 5 a.m. That sound, sound reasonable to everyone?

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 30:24

Yes, sir.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 30:25

Okay. And then everyone, once we're there, all you guys can load up all your luggage into my truck. And then we just need two vehicles to transport guys. And yeah, we just head straight to the, head straight to SeaTac Park. And I don't think, I don't think airport security is going to take very long at all considering it's not even a holiday weekend.
