I, Ashley Toten, under penalty of perjury, state as follows:

- 1. On October 19th, 2004 I spoke with MPD regarding the criminal case of Marvin Haynes, Jr. I answered their questions about Marvin and identified his photo in a line-up.
- 2. I became involved in this case because I was one of the individuals who hung out with Marvin Haynes and the other witnesses in this case. I was 16 years old at the time. I never heard anything from Marvin about the flower shop murder, and I never thought Marvin was involved.
- 3. I felt the police officers pressured me to say certain things about Marvin. They asked me questions about his character, including if I ever had seen him with guns. The truth is I did not know Marvin that well, but the officers kept asking me questions about guns. I was confused and I believe I told them I had seen Marvin with guns before, but it seemed like they were trying to frame Marvin as a dangerous person.
- 4. I do not believe Marvin committed the murder. I believe the police officers asked me specific questions to make Marvin seem like someone capable of such a crime. I was young and afraid, and so was Marvin.
