
STATEMENT OF OFFICER ULBERG #7359 ON 05/16/04 AT 1725 HOURS, TYPED BY JE, CCN 04-117071

On above date and time, while working marked squad with my partner, Officer HEIPLE driving, we responded to the above address on a report of a 911 open line. Dispatch then informed us the call was being updated to a robbery with shots fired.

Upon our arrival I observed the victim to be lying face down in the middle hallway towards the rear of the business area. Rescue was there and pulled him to the front of the business because they needed more room to work on him. Because of the extent of the victim's injuries Rescue made the decision that the victim was DOA and paramedics were cancelled.

Sgt. KJOS, squad 406 responded and while checking the scene I observed a projectile near the victim. I marked this with a blue card. Car 710 was called and responded and per Sgt. KEEFE, I secured the scene from the front door.

Car 21 responded as well as the ME. The ME took custody of the body. Witness accounts that two shots had been fired and I went to the back room and observed the holes from the second bullet. I notified Sgt. KEEFE and Car 21. Car 21 recovered this round also.
