

## SEARCH WARRANT

On 5/19/04 SGT MATTSON presented a search warrant to the Honorable Judge Steven Pihlaja of Hennepin County Court. Judge Pihlaja signed a search warrant for HAYNES' residence to include a night time search.

Investigators requested the assistance of a uniformed squad and the CRT team from Fourth Precinct. The leader of the CRT team was Officer GRANT SCHNEIDER and the K9 Officer was officer MURPHY. Uniformed officers were Officers LEWIS and LEONE. The search warrant was executed at about 2100 hours. SGT MATTSON searched a bedroom on the northwest corner of the main level which was said to be the bedroom of MARVIN HAYNES and recovered a gray hooded sweatshirt. Also from the basement area was a gray Old Navy brand sweatshirt/hoodie on a hanger and a gray fleece zip up liner/sweatshirt on a hanger. There was a pair of gray gym pants and a pair of black gym pants from an upstairs bedroom and also a dark gray pants and jacket combination which I had also found in MARVIN's bedroom. There were also two mailings recovered showing MARVIN's mother, SHARON SHIPP, and MARVIN HAYNES to reside at this address

SGT KEEFE spoke to MARVIN HAYNES' mother SHARON SHIPP and asked her if she could tell me where MARVIN HAYNES was from Friday, May 14 - the current date Wednesday, May 19, 2004. This interview with SHARON SHIPP was secretly recorded. In short SHARON SHIPP could not be sure where her son was from Friday through Wednesday except for Sunday night when she went to the bar. SHARON SHIPP said her son was home at around 7 pm on Sunday, May 16 for dinner but he wasn't hungry. Specifically regarding Sunday, May 16 all she could say was that he was in and out all day Sunday. After talking to SHARON I talked to her daughter MARVINA SHIPP and she told me the last time she saw her brother was a week ago. I then spoke with MARQUITA HAYNES and she told me the last time she saw her brother was on Monday. When I asked her if she recalled seeing him on Sunday she said she could not remember. And finally I spoke to his oldest sister LAKIESHA WRIGHT and she said the last time she saw her brother was on Tuesday morning and before that she had no idea when she saw him last but she definitely did not see him on Sunday, May 16.

After talking to MARVIN's mother and sisters I searched the exterior of their home and while doing it I decided to call for a K9 because the grass was very long in the backyard and it was dark. I specifically requested the bomb dog because this is the dog that is used to search for guns and ammunition. OFFICER MURPHY arrived and searched the exterior and then the interior of the home. SHARON SHIPP's red Ford Taurus MN MBA493 was impounded and taken to the forensic yard pending a search warrant.
