SUPPLEMENT OF SGT MATTSON, TYPED BY KP, CCN 04-117071

On 6/21/2004 I obtained from Hennepin County prosecuting attorney MICHAEL FURNSTAHL a court order to obtain a DNA sample from AP MARVIN HAYNES JR.

On 6/22/2004 at approx. 12:20 per instruction from prosecutor MICHAEL FURNSTAHL, I phone MR HAYNES defense attorney KASSIUS BENSON to let him know that we would go obtain a DNA sample from his client and to invite him along if he wished to come. MR BENSON phone me back at approx. 12:25 and left a message that he did not need to go along.

On 6/22/2004 at approx. 1310 hours SGT KEEFE and I went to HCJ to obtain a DNA sample from AP HAYNES. I brought with us a BCA Buccal swab kit. I used rubber gloves to handle the kit contents and I first open the kit and made sure the contents were there. I then while wearing runner gloves swabbed the inside of MR HAYNES left cheek for 30 seconds per the instructions and then his right cheek for 30 seconds following the instructions and then swabbed around his mouth per the instructions for salvia to make sure there was an adequate sample. I then took this swab and applied it to the two sample cards. These sample cards and swab were then brought back to room 108 where they were locked up overnight so that they could dry per the instructions. On the 23rd I then took these samples and placed them in their proper envelopes and placed seals over them and placed them in their singular mailing envelopes and put a seal over that. I then hand carried this Buccal swab kit to the property and evidence room where I entered it into evidence and then immediately signed it out (for chain of custody) and hand delivered this item to the BCA lab along with two items from PI number 014554 which was some green wrapping paper from the scene of the crime and a greeting card from the scene of the crime that the suspect may have come into contact. There were delivered to the BCA in separate envelopes and separate from the Buccal swab so that there was no cross contamination. These items were delivered to the BCA lab for a DNA comparison to determine if the suspect left any DNA sample on items in the crime scene and if so if these match HAYNES DNA.

Also SGT KEEFE and I went to the property warehouse and obtained items line number 1 - 6 with PI number 015363 which was items of clothing taken from a search warrant at HAYNES residence to be evaluated for any firearms type residues. These items were hand delivered to the BCA by SGT KEEFE and myself.
