Q. I am speaking with ANTHONY MICHAEL TODD. Is that your full name ANTHONY?
R. Yes.

Q. And what's your birth date ANTHONY?
R. [REDACTED] 1990.

Q. ANTHONY do you recall myself and another detective talking to you on June 18, 2004 at approximately 10:00 in the morning?
R. Yep.

Q. At that point in time did you give us a statement regarding MARVIN HAYNES?
R. Yes.

Q. When you were asked if you heard MARVIN or anyone else talking about hitting a lick or robbing someone, do you recall what you told me? Do you recall me asking you if you heard MARVIN talk about robbing anyone or robbing someone?
R. Yes.

Q. On the morning of May 16, 2004?
R. Yes.

Q. And did you additionally tell me that no you never ever heard anybody say anything about a robbery or hitting a lick?
R. Yes.

Q. And now after talking with you here this afternoon, it's my understanding that the reason you said that was because you were scared of MARVIN and getting involved in this case. Is that correct?
R. Yes.

Q. So actually then on the morning of May 16, 2004 when you were outside in front of MUFFY's house did you hear LITTLE MARVIN say anything about hitting a lick or robbing someone or some place?
R. Yes.

Q. What exactly did he say? Do you recall?
R. Finnin to hit a lick on somebody.

Q. He said I am fixin' to hit a lick on somebody?
R. Yes.

Q. Okay. About how many times did he say that?
R. Like four, five times.

Q. And did you see him holding a gun or weapon or anything at that time?
R. No.

Q. But nonetheless you did hear him say three or four times that he was going to hit a lick and when he said he was going to hit a lick that means he was going to rob someone or someplace. Is that correct?
R. Yes.

Q. You also told me that about 7 months before this you saw MARVIN steal a silver revolver from a friend of yours. Is that correct?
R. Yes.

Q. What exactly did MARVIN do regarding this silver revolver? How did he steal the gun? Who did he steal it from?

R. Stole it from my friend JAMAR and he - my friend. They asked my friend JAMAR to sell it to him and he was like no it's my dad's gun and then he snatched it from him and told him to walk away before he shoots.

Q. So your friend JAMAR actually had his dad's pistol and MARVIN stole it from JAMAR and JAMAR asked for him to give it back. LITTLE MARVIN refused and actually threatened to shoot him. Is that correct?

R. Yes.

Q. On the morning of May 16, 2004 when you guys were in front of MUFFY's house how was MARVIN acting?

R. Like he was mad!

Q. He was mad. Okay. Was he making kind of a mean, mean face?

R. Yeah.

Q. Okay. You also mentioned that you've known MARVIN to make the comment or words similar to 'you think this is a joke'?

R. Yes.

Q. Okay so when MARVIN says to people 'do you think this is a joke or this isn't a joke' it that when he is usually trying to gain control over someone or get them to do what he wants them to do?

R. Yes.

Q. Has he ever done that to you?

R. Yes.

Q. When did he do that to you?

R. When he hit me in the head with that gun.

Q. Okay. But he actually hit you in the head once with a gun?

R. Yes.

Q. And was that after he stole the gun from JAMAR?

R. Yes.

Q. Why did he hit you in the head with the gun?

R. Because he wanted my coat and hoodie.

Q. He wanted your coat and your hoodie?

R. Yes.

Q. And what did you tell him?

R. I didn't give him my hoodie and my coat.

Q. So what happened?

R. My friend told me, he told me don't give him my coat and LITTLE MARVIN was like you think is a joke and he told POOPY and them to watch out for him.

Q. So he told you, he said to you, he said "do you think this is a joke?"

R. Yes.

Q. And then what did he do?

R. Pulled out a gun and hit, tried to hit me in the head with it.

Q. Okay and was that the same gun that he stole from JAMAR or was it a different gun?

R. It looked like it was a different gun.
