

June 10th Rally Plan of Action

- Arrive at venue no later than 9:30 a.m. Once you arrive, be counted and listen to the plan.
- Form up behind Obelisk opposite end of reflection pool from Monument. Two columns will then march in formation to the AOR.
- Once on site, ranks will be formed 10-20 wide. First rank will be those with shields. Second and so on are there to provide support. Those deemed to be armed security will stick to certain areas, listen to leaders for direction.
- Random individuals are not to walk through/into the formation, the same goes for anyone with cameras, or journalists.
- Armed security will then be deployed to guard the rear the flanks. No one armed will engage in any leftists or patriot groups.
- If things go sideways and there is violence all in attendance will be expected to use defensive violence to protect themselves, brothers and all patriot groups in attendance. Remember, the patriot groups are not the enemy. If confronted, seek to defuse the situation.
- We will have multiple bull horns and leadership will have access to them. All messaging will be decided beforehand and should be conformed to. We are there to provide a coherent message and an air of leadership to those in attendance not incoherently rant at commies.
- Speakers will be determined beforehand, if you are not a speaker, do not speak to press or talk in any way that would represent the group. If you are approached by a journalist, direct them to the nearest designated speaker.

WHAT TO BRING

- White Polo
- Khaki/Light Brown Pants
- Gloves (optional)

- Boots & Belt (black or brown)
- Helmet (optional)
- Shield (If you have one)
- Legal Defensive Weapons
- VA Hats and Masks (mask optional) (will be available for \$15 cash)
- Flagpoles/Flags (if you do not have a flag, bring a pole, and vice versa)

We suggest bringing a bag which can hold a helmet, defensive baton, or other gear you do not want on your person. These can be left in cars or otherwise nearby and will be guarded.
