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Accuracy of transcripts and speaker identities

Unicorn Riot has done our best to compile transcripts with the most accurate time stamps and speaker identifications possible. Due to the combination of machine transcription and extensive human labor, there may be occasional errors in speaker IDs indicated in transcripts. but we are confident that the vast majority of the speaker IDs and content are correct. Some transcript timestamps are incorrect due to unavoidable issues with using machine transcription at scale, however, the majority are accurate.

Please note that these recordings may include Patriot Front members whose voices were not identified by us. When we were unsure about a speaker's identity we have left that line in the transcript without an assigned name, which machine transcription services usually tag as 'Unknown'. Many Patriot Front members have been identified by researchers, activists and journalists by linking multiple pieces of evidence to online personas.

However, last minute, went out Saturday night to go scout a couple big, big, big action locations. And so, we scouted those out for a little bit. And I kind of checked them out and deliberated whether or not we could or should do them. And then Ethan and Clarke and I stencilled up the walls across the street from the city hall in downtown Seattle. And with some, with some of the big banner stencils, the URL ones and that was across the street from their big Black Lives Matter mural that they see outside their front office window in the city hall. So I'm sure that those people are going to enjoy that if that's still up by tomorrow morning when they go to work. However, I have a feeling it already got taken care of. And then after that, we headed over to Capitol Hill. And we went to the CHAZ zone, right? Yeah. Capitol Hill Autonomous Zone. And it was absolutely popping, super busy night. Tons of good, all the gay bars are out open. There was antifa dressed and all black with like sentries posted around the neighborhood like on their little Nazi watch. And we managed to stencil around the whole entire neighborhood with, I want to say 15 or so stencils, right under their noses and, and got some massive butthurt out of them on Twitter. And I'm sure in all their Telegram chats they're absolutely furious. And I imagine tonight they're out and up in arms and up in their patrols and walking around just absolutely just, just furious. So, that was fun to do some boot on the ground style activism with some stenciling. Would have only been a bit better if we had dressed more appropriately and less working class, so people wouldn't have looked at us too much. And have, making those stencils portable. Walking around with the big long stencil like that, it definitely catches people's eyes. We walked by a police off-, two police officers in a cop car, who all of which, they didn't like us, they were glaring at us, [inaudible] to us being masked up carrying around some painted up stencil were up to no good, but clearly they had better shit to do. So they didn't bother us as we walked across the crosswalk right past them. So we definitely need to cut out all of the font that's about one foot tall. Cut those all out on the Coroplast squares and fold them up in accordion-style folds like the big banner stencils. I think that'd be very useful. And then we also need to continue on a project of modifying fire extinguishers to spew paint, which will be ultimately much cheaper, more accessible, and better than the Rusto cans. However, Rusto cans are still going to be, want to be used because they dry fast and you could put a

stencil, whereas the fire extinguisher, it's good for cover ups but that's about it, it's very runny, it's hard to get a stencil on that. Then on top of that, we need to get a projector. Ethan, I gave you the projector, I gave you the cord for, I gave you the, even a, the screen that comes with it. So if you want to use it for your own personal use, you can. But I forgot to give you the remote that goes with it. So it's kind of hard to control the printer without that, my apologies. So we're going to get that and then we can take this take the projector. And you can project any of our fonts or designs onto a wall of materials such as cardboard, or Coroplast, right? And depending on how far you want the projector you can, that, how big you need your stencil, whatever size you want, you can get really specific, right? You just put the projector closer to the wall, and it makes it smaller, farther back makes it larger. Make sense? So I would like to make foot stencils as well. Or maybe, maybe one and a half foot stencils and we can start putting all of our messaging on \$18 banners. I think that would make the banners in general just look way better, way cheaper, so on and so forth. So that's some projects we need to do. Maybe considering, since we're having the Thanksgiving thing next weekend, perhaps we could bust out all the one foot letters and multiple copies of them on Coroplast. After, after dinner. There's an idea. So maybe, maybe we can get around to doing that. I was also thinking, maybe we could go out all of us together and go do some activism. So it kinda depends on how much we're gonna want to do, considering we're all kind of, you know, celebrating Thanksgiving, but what do you guys think? Might as well make the drive [inaudible] we're all driving across the region, right? What do you guys think?

Not really, but like we have him on the server [inaudible] me.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 33:07

I can [inaudible] if you want.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 33:09

Send him the chart.

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 33:11

Will do.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 33:12

With the numbers. I don't know if I want to share everyone's fitness with each other. "No, don't fat shame me, no." We don't have any fatties.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 33:25

Do you want me just to send him the, just the minimum requirements, the thing you sent me like a month ago, or do you want me to send him the chart I have?

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 33:35

Yeah. Because Tyler's helping with fitness, just send him the whole chart. Anyhow so Yeah, that's our [inaudible]

Clarke WA (Jacob Sundt) 33:53

I can't hear you. I have to reconnect.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 33:56

What, oh, me? Okay, anyhow, that covers our fitness. I want everyone to be in the green to be passing. Yeah, that way we all look good and we can keep up. This, this march is going to be a lot of moving around, a lot. Especially for guys that have like, auxiliary roles, like cameras or shields. You guys are going to need to have some top fuckin' cardio to keep up. So that's something to look into. Then for shield guys, we also need to get slightly better bump caps, which John Utah posted. You got to get that done. Sound good? Any questions regarding that system? Alright, cool. Alright. Um, so activity for next week, we got Thanksgiving planned up. Tyler has been pretty much planning it. So, I'm gonna let Tyler take over from here, Tyler.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 39:25

Shoot me the location and address. I'm writing up an action plan right now to send to everybody.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 39:35

Okay, I thought I already sent it to you but I'll send it again.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 39:40

I don't know, probably got lost in a sea of messages. Okay, so I'll get that finished up after this meeting and have it all sent to you guys. Trying to think of some necessary supplies. You know boxing, change of clothes, stuff like that, activism attire. It's kinda up north so try not to dress like anarchists or shitlibs. Just need like two different outfits, like, rural working class or like, shitlib. Like, literally like, dress like a Democrat or dress like a Republican, because like, walking around wearing like Carhartts and Romeos in Seattle was like, "Hey, everyone, look at me, you know, I don't fit in here."

That's how we used to do before the COVID thing. We didn't have masks. That was weird. People would think you're weird. So we just did big glasses like, pit vipers and like, a hat. And like, maybe a hood if you had to. You know for like, certain actions you'd want to wear a mask. Like, if we're doing a mural or like, putting a sticker on some like, shitlib, [inaudible] building. You don't want your face being shown so, stuff like that you'd put a mask on, but otherwise, there was no mask stuff. So the whole mask COVID thing has been just an absolute blessing for us, because previously if six guys wore all wore masks and walked down the street, people would all be very alarmed, right. You're a trooper. Do you know if the North Cal guys are doing anything? Or they're probably like just as far away huh? Sacramento.

Yeah. Well, that's not even where they're based. But yeah, they're, they're way too far away, man. Like, they're also doing something that day, so don't worry about it.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 47:23

Regardless, we don't have any banners stockpiled and we need to get all that stuff, those new stencils cut out. So we definitely should stockpile some banners and send guys home with some as well. Regardless if we go out and put some up or not.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 47:43

Yeah, I think making them and other stuff would be the way to go and then going out and doing stickers. Because I just I can't think of any place to drop a banner and I know those highways pretty well.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 47:58

Maybe, maybe like there's a river with like a railroad bridge facing the road and maybe we could secure one on the on of that, you know, facing, facing...

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 48:09

Unless you guys want to travel like an hour down south to like Index or, like, but those are really low population areas. But there are down there. It's kind of out in the sticks where we're going.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 48:26

Okay, gotcha.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 48:30

But I'll, I'll look around dude, but I can't think of any, any overpass out there that would be [inaudible] the overpass once you get away from the interstate going out that way like it's just it's all mountains and rural roads Okay, well I'll come up with something by then. Otherwise I... But there are bridges, we could probably find some, like, bridges to stencil, if you really wanted to do that.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 49:01

Yeah, I mean banners don't always have to face, they don't always have to drape over the freeway, they can face it, you know, be suspended from a building or from the side of like, the railroad train crossings, big fences or even like, cliff sides, right? We could get concrete stakes and some paracord and we could use concrete stakes and drill them into the ground above like, the cliff sides facing the the I-90 freeway towards Spokane. You know, we can flip it off of a cliff like that. You know, I've considered that, you know, we, there's other things we can do besides just zip tying them to overpasses.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 49:40

Okay, well I can't think of any good spots, but we'll figure it out.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 49:49

Yeah, really nice. We have posters. Walter, don't you have posters? [Inaudible] use them.

Walter ID 49:59

Yeah. I've got some around.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 50:01

Okay, so maybe potentially we could put up posters. I imagine if there's a town there's electrical boxes, right, so, maybe, yeah, Walter, add those to your your packing list and bring those just in case and I'll bring glue and stuff.

Frederick OR (Lawrence Norman) 50:20

Yeah, posters would be fine, again, I expect it's going to be raining but, we'll make it work.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 50:31

I imagine there's not a lot of opposition that are gonna tear them down anyways. We've, we've done, like, we've done posters in like, Gold Bar, I think, and that shit stayed up for months and months and months like, six months before like, the, like, BLM came and had like a protest there and then they saw the stuff and they started taking it down.

That reminds me that well, you said, you brought up Gold Bar. I think it's [inaudible]. That's right, Gold Bar and it's just before Index. The railroad, well, the rail line runs through there.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 51:05

There's like four or five rail cars that have been sitting there for months that have been tagged up. I think it's in Gold Bar, that would be perfect for stenciling. And down the road is Index, not far, and that bridge is where I saw some antifa stencils and a rainbow on the railroad bridge there.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 51:29

Okay, so, maybe those big, those big, the graffiti spots facing the street we could deploy our big "Reclaim America" and have it face the street with our URL under it?

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 51:39

Uh, well, you want to, if you're talking about doing that over Thanksgiving that, we'd have to do some planning and again, that's like, from where we're going to be, it's like, an hour and a half drive.

ND - John WA (Colton Brown) 51:55

Yeah, so after dinner we drive out and do it and then come back.

Frederick OR (Lawrence Norman) 52:00

If everyone wants to do that, I mean, I don't know, dinner, I don't know what time dinner is gonna, be but we'll see.

Tyler WA (James Johnson) 52:07

Something I was thinking is maybe if we made a bunch of those political signs I was repurposing, and we've got a bunch of those, we can just go stake them around the, some of the rural highways out there at like, interchanges and whatnot, where theres stop signs where people are coming.

But like, they, like, a more legal form of activism, like placing those around, they'll, they'll probably love it, they won't even like, fuck with it, there's no opposition, they probably, it'd be awesome. So that's something that we should definitely try to do and get more of and just find more of those signs. I'll keep an eye out, I drive past a lot by, at work, but we're going to need you all, everyone is going to have to collect some of those if we are going to make a night of driving around doing that, because those go through, they're quick, you know?
