2021-12-10 National meeting post demo

These recordings were taken by an anonymous source inside of Patriot Front during August to December 2021. Unicorn Riot has produced transcript PDFs, MP3s and videos from this set of recordings. The transcripts and the Mp3s use the same set of timecodes. The main report on our website uses separate timecodes that match our videos, which are lightly edited to remove silence, with an additional introduction and credits.

The .mp3 files (as opposed to slightly shortened videos) represent the uncut documentation of these Patriot Front voice meetings. These uncut audio files have been altered as little as possible in the interests of source protection.

Accuracy of transcripts and speaker identities

Unicorn Riot has done our best to compile transcripts with the most accurate time stamps and speaker identifications possible. Due to the combination of machine transcription and extensive human labor, there may be occasional errors in speaker IDs indicated in transcripts. but we are confident that the vast majority of the speaker IDs and content are correct. Some transcript timestamps are incorrect due to unavoidable issues with using machine transcription at scale, however, the majority are accurate.

Please note that these recordings may include Patriot Front members whose voices were not identified by us. When we were unsure about a speaker's identity we have left that line in the transcript without an assigned name, which machine transcription services usually tag as 'Unknown'. Many Patriot Front members have been identified by researchers, activists and journalists by linking multiple pieces of evidence to online personas.

But let's not forget the long hours of editing, formatting, classifying and sorting that goes into this gargantuan task. Nor are those who coordinate these efforts beyond our gratitude. Anything that you believe should be shared with the organization, the membership at large, something that's inspiring, encouraging, educating, funny even, who knows, right? Please make sure that finds its way to Walter Idaho. So shout out to the #socialmedia channel, moving on. I know during a lot of the, of the event, people were using a lot of various, uh, various applications to keep in touch with each other. You know, there was a lot of Threema and Telegram calls, messages, some little chat rooms going on. Totally fine, because that's what had, had to happen to get everything moving and get everything finished. I totally understand. But now that that is over, I want everybody to be on their best behavior with standardized communications platforms. I want you to go through your Threema chat, your, your uh, your Telegram, your whatever. I don't, I don't know if any of you are talking with the boys on Snapchat, but that too. Go through and delete any messages pertaining to the event. Delete any messages pertaining to any chat rooms, photos, videos, anything at all pertaining to the event. Or any photos you took, any, any discussions you had, any photos you took at camp, go ahead and make sure to scrub all that. Don't worry, we have piles and piles of promotional content taken by our professional camera teams, you do not need to take any of your own. Planning and discussions, provided it's not immensely valuable and needed at this moment, should be scrubbed, deleted, so that there is no digital footprint. If we have any questions on that, you may message me directly. Alright, please give me just a few moments while I catch up on DMs because some of these next things will have questions. Just one moment, please, John, I will be able to get to your matter at a later date. Also, please fix your profile picture. Okay, [inaudible]. Okay, so, as well, we have updated our practices on meeting intermediates, those who have passed an interview online but still have not passed an interview in person. So they are in an intermediate stage. That's why we call them that. I'm not going to go over the changes right now. But if you are someone who is meeting those individuals, I would ask, I would ask that you make sure to message me if you have any questions about that. And I will get to it. If you are a director, you should have it already. And directors and others just make, and others who may practice them, make sure if you are if you're vetting people and you're not in a network, please make sure you can contact your nearest director and see if they would be able to help you. Not only help you digitally online in terms of mentorship and counsel, but also maybe even make the trip over, maybe it aligns, because there's going to be a lot of new guys. And we need to get them all handled, we need to get them all processed timely and safely. So yes. And if you are in a network, remember that only the Network Director plus two other authorized and consistent individuals, can't swap around, are cleared to vet intermediates. And during during non-network meetings, we want to keep it similarly sparse. Make sure that no one is meeting an intermediate unless they are very much equipped to do so, mentally, physically, socially, and informationally. That's a word, right? Speaking of informationally, I would like every single one of you to go and review the information security guide. There was some recent information, information risks that we saw, and they have all been guashed, fully and absolutely. But after that, I thought to myself, I need to go through the information security guide and make some updates based on what we've learned. And I found myself poring over the bullet points and the sections and finding out that by golly gee whiz, it's all there already. I didn't need to add anything all that important. Of course, there might be updates made to it anyways, on the nature of good faith, but the principles therein are laid out. And you, yes you, should go and give it another look. Ask yourself, am I following this guide? Ask myself are my peers following this guide, to Directors, especially, this is incumbent upon you and your responsibilities. The rest of you, it is also incumbent upon you and your responsibilities. Everyone holds everyone accountable. Why is that so, because everyone shares in the risk. We are one column, we are one wall, we are one organization and we are only ever as strong as our weakest shield, we are only ever as far forward as our furthest man, we are a single entity. So everyone's safety is the responsibility of everyone, hold each other accountable. And if you have any questions or beliefs that there is any suspicious activity going on, you bring that to me. At the event, we were able to deliver quite the number, almost two dozen orders made with the print shop. I was not

personally overseeing this process. I had a group of others be able to do it. Of course, I was a part of it. Absolutely. But I wasn't able to personally physically see every box I got given out. So it is possible. It is possible and that we are fallible that there might have been some some orders that got mixed up, mismatched, maybe there's some missing items. I don't know, if you received an order at the event and it something seems off about it, maybe was missing posters, for example, I know I went home with more poster sets than I was thinking I would. Please message me directly and I will make sure to send out those extra items to you. Also make sure to give me your, your order number. Of course we love the honor system. But don't come to me and say that I didn't give you an extra \$500 worth of the promat because I'm going to need to check that. So, so please double check your order numbers if you received an order, if there is any outlying unrequited stuff you didn't get. In other words, I will make sure that gets to you. In other news, as part of our new enhancements of technological security, because we love our tech team, don't we folks? We will be, soon, very soon in a number of, short number of days, discontinuing the mobile application. Now, this is only the mobile application. So if you use the RocketChat mobile application on your phone, mobilely, then you will no longer be able to do that in a very short number of days, say 72 hours. This is for some security flaws that are present only in the mobile application, we will be doing other means, as this goes on, to ensure that your accessibility and your ease of calm communication in the server as it stands is aided in every way we see fit. But remember, mild inconvenience is of using the server and a browser application on your cell phone is nothing compared to the rather sizable inconvenience of security risk. I hope we all agree on that. So yes, while certain matters might be cumbersome, that is the, that is the burden of our great need for information and communication. Many of you have no idea just how many people need to talk to each other, share vital information, documents, images, etc. to help this organization move along. It is a great and beautiful machine that we have built that turns raw manpower into disciplined ranks. And it requires quite the logistical backbone, all of which we uphold. Moving on, and final notes before we get into the open forum, which is going to be, remember, questions are to be delivered to me in the direct messages and I will answer them here that way, you are not to speak. So we will be moving into forward planning for 2022. I will tell you that, that we have attended the the March for Life events in several cities around the country for many years now, going on four years now. So I hope it's not too much of a security risk to say that we're probably going to do it again this year. If anybody, you know, you know, antifa is out there with memories of goldfish perhaps. So, so, so yes, please, please stay ready. And we might have some more demonstrations coming up in the, in the next month or so. But do not worry too much. Because these are going to be very well planned. And we will be among friends at these events. These people at these, these March For Life Events have really come to support us in the, over the years. And because of the last year's cancellations of these events, we are expecting even larger crowds of supportive individuals who will no doubt have much more likely heard of us and have strong, strong opinions about our efforts, our, in our privations to see the nation free. So please stand by your Directors, your organizers your points of contact for instruction on these events. But nonetheless, if you needed any additional motive to keep yourself fit, in shape, ready and responsive, then there you go. Moving beyond that, we will be planning the rest of our year for 2022. I have a number of fantastic ideas planned and I think all of you will find immense joy and immense gratitude in these events taking place. Of course, in case any of you didn't know, we will be doing something for Independence Day. I don't know where and I frankly, I don't know what. But we will be doing something for Independence Day, I remember speaking to a man for last Independence Day, who did not take the weekend off because he was not sure if we were doing anything. Let there be no

doubt we will be doing something on Independence Day or the otherwise nearest weekend. So obviously it's quite early, but plan to be available. And yes, generally, you know, we will have the weekends that you will be asked to be available. So just generally, you know, be prepared, we will move into 2022 with a vengeance, with a steadfast and ferocious vigor to see our accomplishments realized. Our recent action was the culmination of 18 months of labor and improvement, recruitment. And now is the time where it pays off. Alright, any other questions? Jack Arizona, where can we watch the speeches on the mountaintops? Odyssee, Bitchute, and they will be up on the website shortly. We've been a little busy. Any other questions anybody has for me? DM them to me now? Questions, comments, concerns, suggestions, ideas? I'll read them out loud if it is pertinent, or I will just answer the guestion. I've dumped a lot of information on there. Has the meeting concluded, what about okay, yes, yes, yes, yes. We are cataloguing the unplanned expenses from our recent action. And we will be committing a, a very large effort to ensure that everybody's unplanned expenses are accounted for. So, so yes, please, be at the ready for that if you have online means of payment transferal, or you wish to do the snail mail option, which is old reliable as far as I'm concerned.
